

The township of Murwillumbah is located within the Tweed River catchment in northern NSW and is ho

The township is protected from flooding by 4 levee systems including Commercial Road Levee, East Mu

Major floods in 1954 and 1974 resulted in inundation of the Murwillumbah CBD. Ex-tropical cyclone Deb

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In 2014, the 'Tweed Valley Floodplain Risk Management Study' (WBM BMT, 2014) was published. The study recommended that a detailed local drainage study be undertaken for Murwillumbah to investigate drainage behind the levees, the performance of the pumping stations, the risks of overtopping of the levees, as well as potential mitigation options that could reduce the extent and frequency of flooding across the township. Accordingly, Council has resolved to prepare the Murwillumbah CBD Levee Drainage Study.

The study is being prepared by engineering consultancy, [Catchment Simulation Solutions](#), who have completed many similar studies across NSW.
